Dear Ms. Centers and Ms. Culhane,

Luke Chapter, Military Officers Association of America (Luke Chapter) submits this Final Report to MOAA's Community Foundation. This consolidated report closes activity under the initial MOAA grant agreement dtd 1 May 2020, and the Covid-19 Grant Agreement dtd 27 May 2020. We are compliant with both Grant Agreements to the best of our knowledge.

Our program has grown by leaps and bounds. Grants from MOAA and Arizona Department of Veterans Services motivated more donations from our chapter members, leading to more charitable grants to veterans. More needy veterans got help they desperately need.

The MOAA Community Foundation Outreach grant of \$5,000 was received from MOAA's Community Foundation in May 2020. The second \$5,000 was received in mid-June for Covid-19 relief. Although separately issued, both grant agreements specify essentially the same purposes as we proposed, to provide veterans' relief of financial emergencies for personal, housing and household/food needs. In addition to the two MOAA grants, the Arizona Department of Veterans Services (ADVS) granted \$4,999 in July 2020. These three sources provided the basic grant pool for this fiscal year of \$14,999 in funds to be administered by Luke Chapter its Veterans Relief and Covid-19 Grant pool.

We supplemented these external grants with our own chapter resources. Luke Chapter MOAA Community Fund, Inc., is an IRS Section 501(c)(3) public charity and single-member subsidiary of Luke Chapter MOAA. Our Community Fund approved additional grants in recent Board meetings to supplement the MOAA and AZ grants. Our Community Fund authorized direct payment of 1) \$1,250 to Eugene Ramos who was nominated by (parent) Luke Chapter's Veterans Relief Grant Fund committee; 2) \$1,250 to provide food relief to eligible veterans and

active-duty members during the Thanksgiving holiday period; 3) \$1,177 for a future veteran grant applicant; and 4) \$7,500 for housing support to veteran Landon Smith who was nominated by parent Luke Chapter. Several Veterans' Relief Committee members also made personal donations to date of about \$908 to date paid directly to and on behalf of individual grant recipients, to help meet their needs above the chapter-granted funds.

Our program has processed sixteen veteran grant cases to date with grant awards made to fourteen applicants. Food donations and commissary gift cards were made to Luke Air Force Base airmen at Thanksgiving. Below is a summary of revenues and disbursements to date:

We completed four notable grant cases since our third quarter report, which are detailed in the enclosed Case Summary (Attachment A) and reflected in the enclosed photos. The grant of \$7,500 for the benefit of Landon Smith was paid to Gila House, Inc., an IRS 501(c)(3) public charity. This grant was made entirely with Luke Chapter Community Fund money and not from MOAA Community Foundation (see Case Summary, item #15).

Of note since the last report, was our Thanksgiving Holiday food drive and related grant. For ten years, Luke Chapter has conducted a food collection drive in October-November of canned and packaged foods for distribution prior to the Thanksgiving Holiday. The program is called "Turkeys for Troops." Our beloved Chaplain, Rev Fannalou Guggisberg, has organized and supervised our chapter program through the years. Fannalou and other chapter volunteers worked cooperatively with the nearby Luke AFB Chaplain's Office and Luke AFB Base First Sergeants working group, and local food banks. The base First Shirts develop a list of activeduty airmen (all ranks) who together with their families would most benefit from food distribution in kind. These folks were invited to come to the Chaplain's office on base and pick up canned and packaged food, a large turkey, and commissary cards while they lasted.

The COVID-19 epidemic prevented chapter meetings in person. Nonetheless, Luke Chapter members donated a record number of nearly 1000 cans and packages of food for distribution at Turkeys for Troops. In addition, our Luke Chapter Community Fund granted \$1,250 to purchase 50 commissary gift cards for distribution. We estimate this food support reached at least 250 active-duty airmen and family members, making their holiday a bit brighter.

Administration of the grant program continues to be challenging during the Covid-19 pandemic crisis, as detailed in prior reports. Everything takes more volunteer time and effort to accomplish. We have expanded funding well beyond the grant money provided by MOAA's Community Foundation and by the AZ Department of Veterans Services. Luke Chapter MOAA will continue its Veterans Relief Grant Fund long as our budgeted funds permit.
